1. Dictionary, Speaking and Listening Skills:-

Learning new words is an essential exercise to build your vocabulary. However along with a good vocabulary you need to have good pronunciation skills as well. Pronunciation is an important part of being understood. Learning to pronounce correctly and finding the meaning of different words takes drilling and constant practice. Pick up a dictionary and look at the arrangement and sequence of words in it. Students need to know how words are arranged alphabetically in a dictionary. Also, they must know how these words are pronounced and the way to pronounce them. Below is a list of 3 apps we recommend for language learners to improve their pronunciation.

Make a Pocket Dictionary.

2. Write it in an alphabetical order. State whether it's a Noun, Verb, Adjective or Adverb.
3. Frame a sentence with correct capitalization and punctuation.

Ex: **D**

delicious : adjective . Sentence : My brother baked a delicious cake.
